Student should go through their planner for each Course and make sure they have enough courses selected to fulfill all graduation Requirements. Everything that has a locked padlock next to it cannot be changed by a student.

Students will have all CORE classes already added in their MYAP and locked.


Students should look at all alerts, see if they are short credits in any core classes (everything except for Electives) and talk about a plan to meet those requirements. Many students will have a suggested course already added in but unlocked.

Once students have made sure they have a plan to meet all CORE required for graduation classes they can start to work on a plan for ELECTIVES.

All students will not have enough credits selected for ELECTIVES, and will need to select more electives for their remaining school years. These can be changed as needed



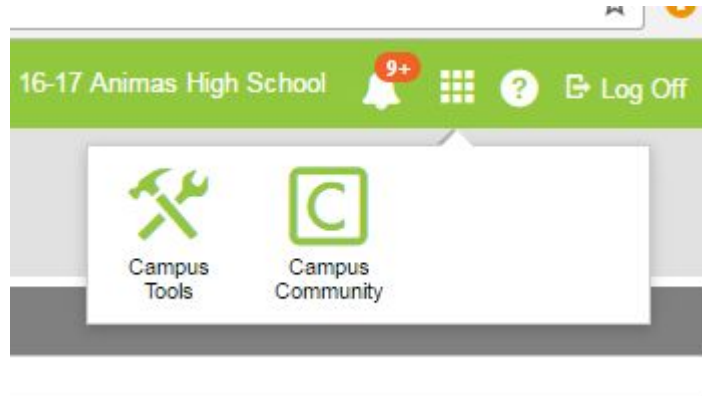
