

The point infraction system is the discipline guideline used by the Transportation Department for misbehavior at the bus stop, on the bus, and in the loading zone. Parent/Guardian contact will be made by a transportation employee prior to a student receiving points and the respective discipline. Transportation will use only one infraction level per incident, per day and per parent/guardian contact. The greater point value will be used if there are several infractions committed by the student during any one day. Points are accumulated during the school year as a result of the student's behavior. The accumulated points determine the consequences given by transportation for each incident. Students are allotted 10 points for the school semester. Once a student has reached 10 or more points they will be suspended for the remainder of the school semester (immediate year-long suspension for fighting, drug use, alcohol use, or possession of a weapon). If the student's school chooses to enforce another type of discipline, the transportation department will continue to enforce it's own discipline.
